Pulse Arts is a Community Interest organisation that makes person-centred, live music interactions in hospitals and hospices with patients, family members and hospital staff. Our work has proven to reduce the stress and anxiety of being in hospital, helps patients manage pain and discomfort, and improve wellbeing during difficult periods of hospitalisation.

Since 2015 we have built an excellent reputation and track record working closely with 4 NHS Trusts and 1 hospice in London and Essex. We currently have 4 ongoing partnerships and regular delivery programmes.

As well as our front-line work, Pulse Arts has emerging partnerships with Trinity Laban Conservatoire of Music and Drama and King's College London with whom we are developing cutting edge new training opportunities for upcoming musicians and medics.

Pulse Arts is local and national advocate for Music in Heath Practice at conferences and events and is helping to develop the National Alliance of Musicians in Healthcare (NAMIH).

Pulse Arts is a small and dedicated team of musicians who have trained in Music in Health practice with OPUS Music CIC. The method was pioneered by Music et Santé in Paris. We foster strong musical and professional relationships within our team which allow us to create high quality musical interactions in sensitive healthcare settings.

## **Job Specification**

### The Post

Pulse Arts CIC is recruiting a new musician to join the team for an initial year-long placement as a Music in Healthcare Trainee. The role would suit a musician who is interested in making Music in Healthcare with Pulse Arts a long-term part of their freelance portfolio.

Working on children's wards at Broomfield Hospital, the trainee will be making music alongside Pulse musicians with patients, family members and hospital staff. They will receive training and mentoring in Music in Heath Practice, attend programme development days in central London, receive professional supervision sessions and attend the National Alliance of Musicians in Healthcare (NAMIH) Conference in Brighton in July 2019.

Subject to the successful completion of the programme, the trainee will be invited to become a full member of the team, continuing to work at Broomfield Hospital and potentially expanding to care of dementia wards and other settings. ### **Essential Qualities:**

- 1. Self-reflective practitioner, able to make music with a strong sense of positive wellbeing for, and with, other people.
- 2. Strong musical, professional, personal skills associated with being a musician in healthcare.
- 3. Excellent, communication and partnership skills.
- A commitment to the full trainee programme and the desire and capacity to make Music in Healthcare practice a key part of your freelance portfolio in the long-term.
- 5. Within commuting distance of both Broomfield Hospital in Chelmsford and Training days in Central London (Zones 1-2).

### <u>Desirable Qualities:</u>

- 1. Completed training with an established Music in Health Organisation: Pulse Arts CIC, OPUS Music CIC, Wishing Well Music, Lime Arts, Musique Et Sante or an equivalent provider.
- 2. Experience of working/setting up/managing music projects in community or healthcare settings.
- 3. Links with Essex arts and musical networks.
- 4. Completed Child Protection Training. Eg. NSPCC Online Course or other.

All Pulse Arts musicians are required to have an enhanced DBS check in the last 12 months and/or registered with the online update service and Public Liability Insurance of up to 5 million.

### **Application Process:**

The deadline for submitting applications is **5pm on the 9th November 2018**.

Shortlisted candidates will be notified and invited to an interview and audition on **29th November 2018 between 9.00 and 5pm** at the Centre for Supporting Voluntary Action,
Burgess Well House, Coval Lane, Chelmsford, CM1 1FW.

At interview, candidates will be asked to demonstrate their musical skills, talk about their application and what they can contribute and gain from the traineeship.
